## Banter Cards

I.

- Of all the fences in Punjar, Boss Ogo is the most cunning and greedy.
- Boss Ogo's shop has been closed for almost a month.
- Sarzuk the Devil's gang has grown a lot since Boss Ogo disappeared.
- Everyone on Kettle Street is saying Sarzuk's gang is going to rob Boss Ogo's shop tonight.

II.

- Boss Ogo keeps pouches of gems in locked drawers in his main shop.
- You walked past Boss Ogo's shop last night. You saw some hooded men casing the place.
- At the tavern, you overheard some of Sarzuk the Devil's men say they are going to rob Boss Ogo's shop around 2 AM.
- Boss Ogo's shop is three floors. You've sometimes seen him staring out from the large rose window on the top floor.

III.

- You once sold some stolen goods at Boss Ogo's jewelry shop. He paid well.
- Sarzuk the Devil used to be Boss Ogo's lieutenant. But there was a falling out and Sarzuk's recruited a lot of Ogo's men.
- Boss Ogo sometimes invites folk into his shop to spend the night - usually the night before they do a job for him.
- A week ago, you talked to a one-eyed man at the tavern who claimed he had killed an elf and stolen her magic dagger.

IV.

- You once tried to sell some fake jewels to Boss Ogo. He spotted them right away and beat you senseless.
- Boss Ogo loves his garden. He walled it off ever since he saw children picking pears from his trees.
- Sarzuk the Devil hates Boss Ogo. He'll likely rob the shop himself then burn it down.
- You last saw smoke from Boss Ogo's chimney four weeks ago. It had an unusual smell.

V.

- A week ago you heard at the tavern that a few amateurs were going to try to sneak into Boss Ogo's shop. You haven't seen them since.
- You delivered a parcel of books to Boss Ogo a few months ago. He tipped you generously.
- The city's been cold lately. Rich men like Boss Ogo hate the cold. He probably went south for a few weeks.
- The city guard does regular patrols around Boss Ogo's house.

VI.

- You saw Boss Ogo at the market a month ago. He was pale and stank with illness.
- Boss Ogo's shop has been dark for weeks. But there's no way Boss Ogo has left his place unguarded.
- You heard Sarzuk the Devil has a deal with the city guard to allow him to recruit condemned men before they are hanged.
- You once sold Boss Ogo some stolen paintings. He said he might store them in his basement.

Hand one card to each of your players (always use #1 and #2). When you kick off the game, players take turns reading or paraphrasing any ONE of their tidbits of information (in any order). Once they've gotten through all of their bullets, the adventure begins normally.
